

SUPPLIES LIST for MIDDLE SCHOOL STUDENTS

These materials are needed **EVERY** day and should travel with students from class to class:

- **LOOSE-LEAF PAPER** (*lots of it!*)
- **PENS** (*Blue or Black*)
- **RED PENS**
- **PENCILS**
- **HIGHLIGHTER**

Students will also need the following subject-related materials:

BIBLE: (*Purchased through religion class; new students will be given information about this purchase.*)

BINDERS: *** **ONE INCH** in size. ***

- 1 WHITE (*Spanish*)
- 1 PURPLE (*Social Studies*)
- 1 BLUE (*Math*)
- 1 GREEN (*Science*)
- 1 RED (*ELA*)

TAB DIVIDERS (*pages with tabs for separating binder sections*):

- approximately 6 packs of 5 dividers

NOTEBOOKS:

- 1 BLUE (*Math*)
- 1 GREEN (*Science Fair journal*)
- 1 YELLOW (*Religion*)
- 1 ORANGE (*Computer*)
- 1 RED and 1 BLACK (*ELA*)

FOLDERS with POCKETS:

- 1 GREEN (*Science*)
- 1 YELLOW (*Religion*)
- 1 RED and 1 BLACK (*ELA*)
- 1 ORANGE (*Computer*)

INDEX CARDS:

- 2 packages (or more!!) of 100 regular-size cards

BOOK COVERS (to cover large textbooks)

- 4 **JUMBO stretch cloth covers** – (if possible: blue, green, purple, white)
- **OR** ... Use large paper bags!

(Grade 6 only): COMPOSITION BOOKS

- One – preferably GREEN (Science In-Class Lab journal)
- One – preferably YELLOW (Religion)

Teachers' Recommendations:

Each student is different and will discover his/her own methods of organizing materials; that is part of the learning process we encourage. However, we include the following suggestions as you purchase supplies for next year:

* Purchasing a separate binder for agenda & in-coming/out-going homework is highly recommended.

* Avoid purchasing BIG "All-in-One" binders. They invite clutter & disorganization and don't fit in desks or lockers.

* Purchasing a separate homework folder or envelope may work best for your child.

* For subject classes, students need *only* a small pouch big enough to hold pens, pencils, eraser, and a highlighter. This might be clipped into student's agenda binder or just carried on top of books. Please do **NOT** buy a pencil box for DAILY supplies.

* White-Out is not allowed in the classroom.

* Gel-Pens & fancy colored pens are not acceptable for written school work; you can avoid buying them.
