Middle School Supply List

Academic Year 2022-2023

All middle school students should have the following supplies with them daily:

- Loose-leaf paper (enough for each subject binder noted below)
- Pens (blue or black)
- Red Pens
- Pencils
- Highlighter
- Appropriate notebooks/folders/binders (see below)
- Headphones for Chromebook use

In addition, students should be prepared with:

- 2 packages (or more) of 100 regular-size index cards
- 4 Jumbo Stretch cloth book covers or use large paper bags
- Scissors
- Colored Markers and Pencils
- Glue sticks
- Dry erase markers
- 1 Pack of Sticky Notes for Literature Class
 - May need to be replenished throughout the year

The following materials are subject specific:

Binders (with appropriate loose-leaf supply in each):

- Literature - Black
- Math - Blue
- Religion - Yellow
- Social Studies - Purple
- Spanish - White
- ELA - Red
- Science - None (*notebook & folder only*)

Tab Dividers:

- Approximately 6 packs of 5 binder page dividers

Teachers' Recommendations:

Each student is different and will discover his or her own methods of organizing materials. This is part of the learning process as students transition to middle school and prepare for high school. The following suggestions are meant to assist in this process:

- Students are encouraged to bring their own small, personal hand sanitizer
- Purchase a separate binder for agenda & in-coming/out-going work
- Avoid purchasing big “all-in-one” binders. They invite clutter & disorganization and do not fit in desks or lockers.
- Purchasing a separate homework folder or envelope may work better for your child.
- For subject classes, students need only a small pouch big enough to hold pens, pencils, erasers, and a highlighter. This could be clipped to a student’s agenda binder or just carried on top of books. Please do not buy a pencil **box** for daily supplies.
- White-out is not allowed in the classroom.
- Gel-pens & fancy colored pens are not permitted for written school work.
- Students are encouraged to purchase a protective cover or case for their Chromebook:
 - Soft cases should fit an 11.6” Chromebook
 - If your child prefers a hard-shell cover, we recommend waiting until they have received their Chromebook and have the model number to ensure proper sizing/fit
